BID DESCRIPTION: DISCIPLINARY AND JUDICIAL PANEL

BID NO: CSA/08/2023/24

Cricket South Africa ("CSA") is the national governing body for the sport of cricket in South Africa. It administers all aspects of South African cricket, men and women, both in the professional and amateur spheres.

NATURE OF SERVICE REQUIRED

The purpose of this bid is to appoint competent and qualified Legal Practitioners to be registered on the CSA's Disciplinary and Judicial Panel for a period of 10 (ten) years. The Disciplinary and Judicial Panel will be appointed as either Judicial Officers, Disciplinary Committee, Judicial Committees and Appeals Committees to resolve, hear and adjudicate any alleged misconducts and non-compliance by CSA's Members, Associate and Ancillaries.

SCOPE OF WORK

- To consider and determine whether a Member, Individual or Person is guilty of misconduct in terms of the memorandum of incorporation, including any question of fact or law necessary to make such a determination and any ancillary matter necessary to make such a determination.
- The Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee must consider the notification of alleged misconduct, as well as the outcome of any inquiry initiated by the President and decide whether:
 - the notification of alleged misconduct is spurious and/or vexatious; or
 - the notification of alleged misconduct is prima facie without merit; or
 - the notification of alleged misconduct prima facie has merit.
- Other Legal Practitioners will be appointed to form part of the Appeals Committee to hear cases of any Member aggrieved by a ruling of a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee appointed in terms of DC and judicial Regulations and shall have the powers to:
 - grant or dismiss the appeal;
 - vary the ruling of the Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee in any manner it deems appropriate in the circumstances;
 - vary the sanction imposed by the Judicial Officer or Appeal Committee in any manner it deems appropriate in the circumstances;

- make any further order which it deems appropriate in the circumstances; or
 - take any other step which it deems appropriate in the circumstances in order to deal with the matter in a manner which is just, fair and equitable
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- To report on the findings of all the rulings within the timeframe agreed upon to the President of Cricket South Africa
