BID DESCRIPTION: CRICKET TEAM SECURITY SERVICES AND SECURITY ASSESSMENT SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF FORTY-SIX (46) MONTHS.

Cricket South Africa ("CSA") is the national governing body for the sport of cricket in South Africa. It administers all aspects of South African cricket, men and women, both in the professional and amateur spheres.

NATURE OF SERVICE REQUIRED

Cricket South Africa NPC ("CSA") is looking to appoint an experienced Security Company to provide Protection/Security services to the Cricket Team and perform security assessment services for a period of forty-six (46) months. The Security company should be able to provide a proposal that articulates the approach to delivering on the objectives with a focus on (but not limited to):

The Service provider will provide security services to Cricket South Africa for the following;

- Providing Risk Assessments for all outgoing and incoming tours for teams of all 'levels';
- Evaluation of host security plans for outgoing tours (as per International Cricket Council (ICC) requirement);
- Development of security plans for incoming tours (as per ICC requirement);
- Complying with all standards and directives of the ICC Anti-Corruption Unit regional security manager and its CSA equivalent, the "local anti-corruption manager";
- Developing security plans and minimum standards on behalf of CSA for each venue in South Africa;
- Representing CSA at all presentations and meetings required to understand and adhere to safety and security matters, e.g., the Sports and Recreational Events Act and any other event security legalization and/or regulations;
- Representing and assisting CSA with their objective of achieving 'major 'event' status for international cricket matches hosted in South Africa;
- The provision of a Team Security Liaison Officer (TSLO) to the Proteas team for all outgoing tours (to be increased if so, indicated by the Risk Assessment);
- The provision of a Team Security Liaison Officer (TSLO) for the home and visiting teams during any incoming tour;
- The provision of a PCT Security Liaison Officer for the Player Control Team (PCT) during any local international series hosted by CSA;
- The provision of service provider staff at each venue to represent CSA as the event organizer in terms of the SASREA, ACT 2 of 2010 to ensure that CSA minimum safety and security standards are being adhered to by the local stadium vendor. This provision shall include a locally based service provider employee to act in the role of 'City-Coordinator' to attend and contribute to the Event Safety and Security Planning Committee (ESSPC) in each city hosting matches under the auspices of CSA;
- Briefing both incoming and outgoing teams and PCTs of all 'levels' on risk assessments and security measures as required.
- Incoming tours to South Africa
- Outgoing tours
